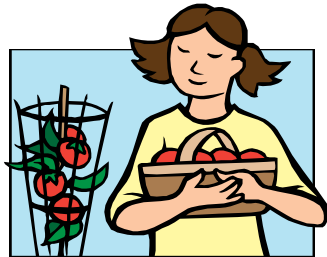


GENERAL INFORMATION AND ENTRY FORM

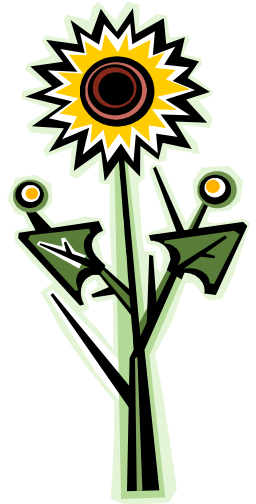
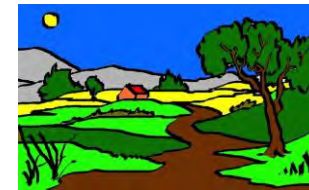
